

**Presidency of the Republic**  
**Republican Decree No. (36) for Year 2005**  
**Composition of the Assessment and Evaluation Commission**

**President of the Republic**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 221 of the Constitution of the Republic of Sudan for Year 2005 together with the provisions of the Republican Decree No. (34) for the Year 2005 and after securing the consent of the 1st Vice President of the Republic; I issue the following Republican Decree:-

**Date and Commencement**

1. This Decree shall be titled "Republican Decree No. (36) for Year 2005 of Composition of the Assessment and Evaluation Commission". It shall come into effect from the date of its signature.

**Tasks of the Commission**

2. The Assessment and Evaluation Commission shall undertake the following responsibilities and tasks:
  - (a) Monitor and assess the CPA implementation during the preliminary and interim periods.
  - (b) Conduct a mid-term evaluation of the unity arrangements established under the CPA.
  - (c) Present report of mid-term evaluation and any other regular reports to the Presidency of the Republic provided that copies of these reports shall be sent to the international organizations and states represented in the Commission.
  - (d) Present advise to the Presidency of the Republic concerning improving the institutions and arrangements created under the CPA for making the unity of Sudan attractive to the people of Southern Sudan.
  - (e) Evaluation of fulfilment of international commitments and support for CPA implementation and encouragement.
  - (f) Formation of verification teams in any questions connected with the CPA.
  - (g) Publish whole, or part of, the Commission's reports after securing the consent of the Presidency of the Republic.
  - (h) Building of self-capacities and secure assistance of the necessary expertise from independent institutions as it may deem suitable.
  - (i) Attract direct international financial aid for steering its works.

**Composition of the Commission**

3. The Commission shall be formed in the following manner:

**Premises and Secretariat of the Commission**

4. The Commission shall establish its offices in Khartoum and Juba and shall have executive secretariat.

**Internal Rules and Regulations**

5. The Commission shall formulate its internal rules and regulations as well as financial systems and the Presidency of the Republic shall approve them.
